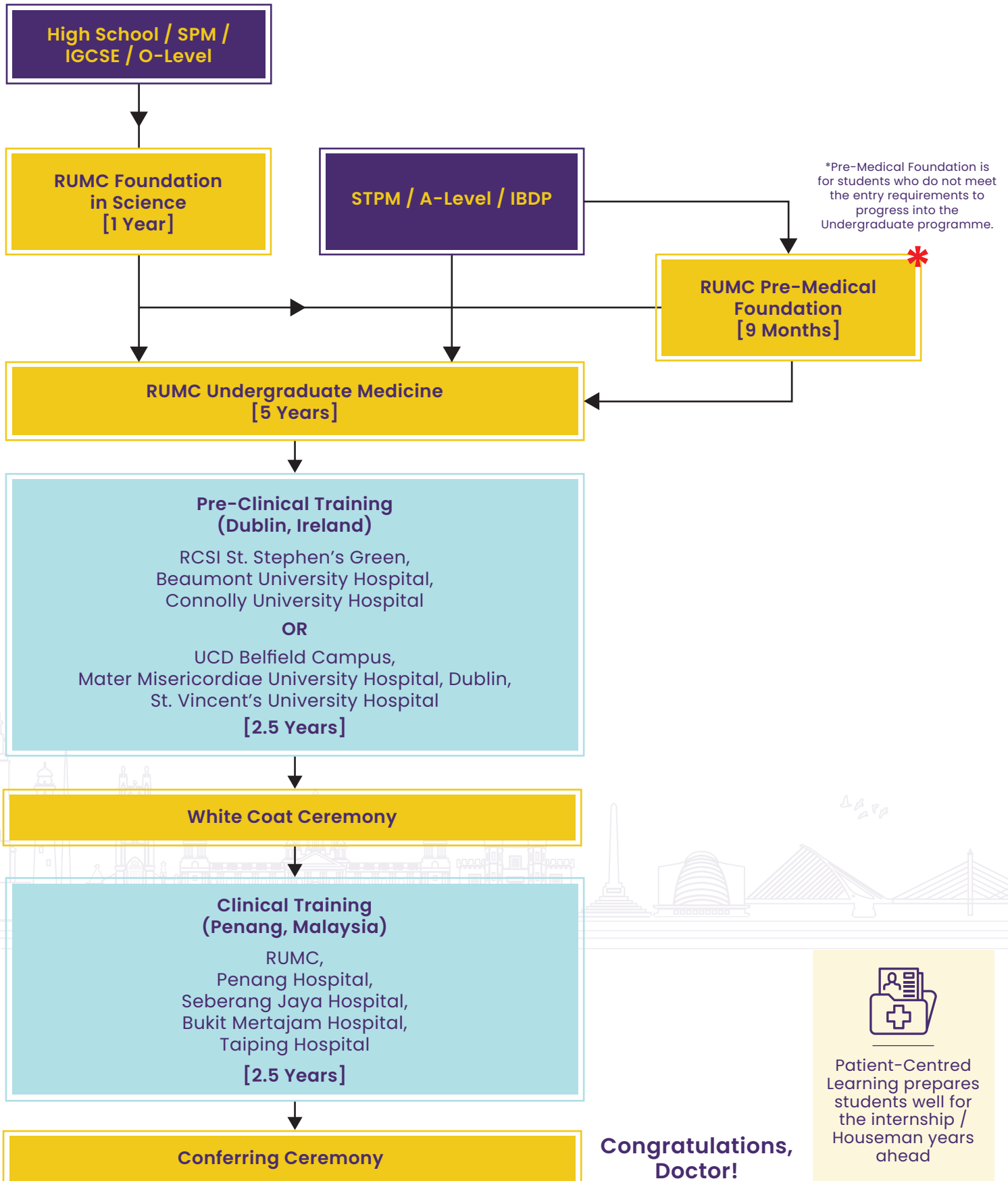

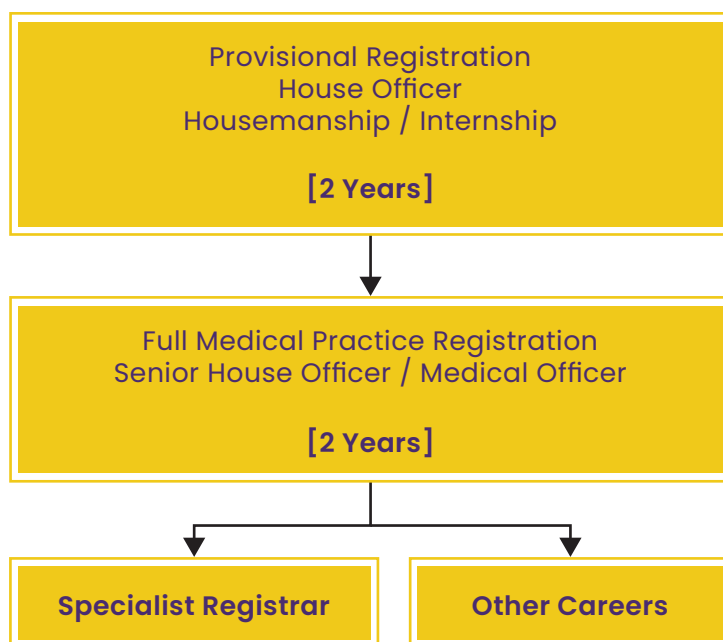
Progression Chart

English Language Requirements

IELTS / TOEFL / CEFR qualifications to be submitted during application.

Prerequisites

A pass in SPM O Level or equivalent with 5 B's each in Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Mathematics Additional Mathematics and another subject at school level or its equivalent.

- The SPM / O Level requirement is not applicable to applicants with STPM / A Level qualifications.

- The SPM / O Level requirement is applicable to applicants with STPM / A Level qualification entering Undergraduate Medicine via Pre-Medical Foundation Year.

Applying to Malaysia's Public Sector?

A PASS in Bahasa Melayu at SPM is required for Housemanship application.

Tuition Fees

The degree you receive from the RUMC programme is identical to the degree conferred on students who undertake their full programme in RCSI or in UCD. This means you are getting the **same degree with the same recognition but at almost one-third the cost.**

The 5-year tuition fees are as follows:

- RM620,000 for Malaysian students
- €155,000 for International students

A fee of RM500 is payable upon submission of application.

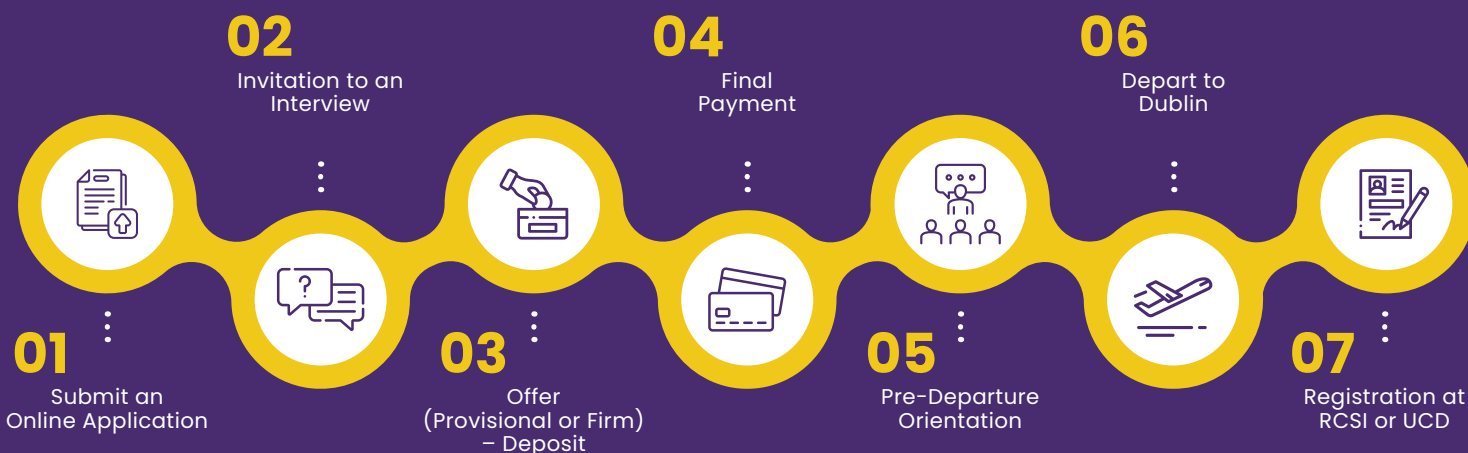

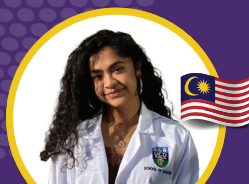
