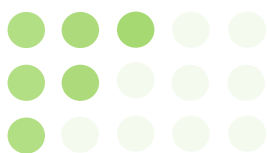

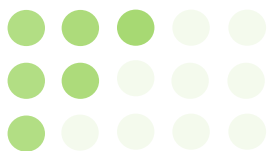

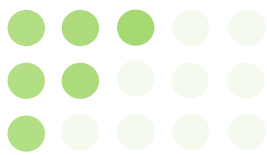

B. A mandatory admissions interview will be conducted twice a month. Any offer holders with an expired offer or pending acceptance who did not attend the interview after the third invitation will be considered as rejected offers.

Prerequisites

All **Pre-Medical (FY)** applicants must present a minimum 5B's in Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, and one additional subject at SPM/IGCSE/O-Level or equivalent. Entry requirements are subject to change by the authoritative agencies/bodies/

Age of Applicant

Any applicant must be of age (18 years old) before departure to Ireland for commencement of the Undergraduate Medicine programme.

Applicants from the European Union (EU)

RUMC does not accept applicants from individuals eligible for the Central Applications Office (CAO). Prospective applicants are advised to confirm their eligibility through the CAO website before applying to RUMC.

International Qualifications not listed in the entry criteria will be submitted to UK ENIC for qualification equivalency assessment against Cambridge A-Levels standard upon complete submission into the application portal. This verification process will take approximately six working days.

Under **certain circumstances**, applicants may be required to complete a **Letter of Undertaking (LOU)**, witnessed by a lawyer or commissioner of oaths, upon receiving the RUMC Offer Letter.

Examples include:

- Applicants holding a passport from a country that does not recognise qualifications from National University of Ireland (NUI).
- Indian applicants who do not intend to practice medicine in India.
- Other criteria to be considered case-by-case basis.

NEET Exam refers to the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test, required for Indian nationals who wish to work in India as a medical practitioner.

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
